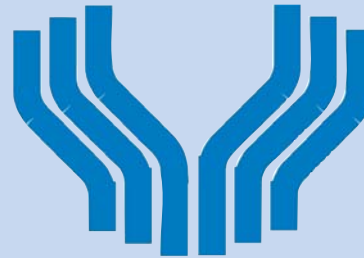
The Asper Helping Hand Initiative is a member of the International Association of Hebrew Free Loans freeloan.org

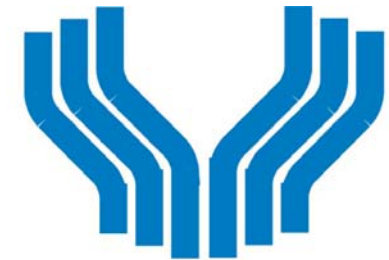
