

Direct Service Provider- Support Worker

Position Overview

Jewish Child and Family Service is looking for a mature and experienced Direct Service Provider (DSP) to provide in home support services to Child and Family Services clients. It is a casual part time position that may require working early evenings and occasionally weekends. Direct Support Worker is expected to work independently and collaboratively with other members of the Child Welfare Team and have experience working with marginalized and immigrant families.

Position requirements:

- Experience in providing in- home support to parents and children with behavioural and emotional issues.
- Must be able to write concise, succinct, and detailed reports in English after each visit.
- Must have a reliable vehicle, clean driver abstract and consistent access to a vehicle a must
- Diploma in Child and Youth Care Worker or university education in the field is favored
- Start of the position is immediate
- First Aid and Non-Violent Crisis intervention certificate is preferred

This position requires a clear Criminal Record Check, Prior Contact and Child Abuse Registry check along with driver abstract.
