WHEN YOU ARRIVE: We will support, guide and connect you along your journey:


- Navigating the challenges of a new cultural and social environment

NEWCOMER EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

GENERAL SERVICES:

The JCFS Settlement team will assist you and your family to integrate to life in Canada and connect with the Winnipeg Jewish community. You will be introduced to the resources available such as: Jewish schools, synagogues, child and youth programs, camps, kosher facilities and volunteer opportunities.

In cooperation with the Jewish Federation of Winnipeg and other Jewish community organizations, JCFS plays a part in helping newcomers make new friends in a relaxed and enjoyable atmosphere. Opportunities are offered to participate in general Jewish community activities and events. Special social and educational events are planned specifically for newcomers and their families by JCFS.

JCFS organizes seminars and workshops on topics that are of interest to newcomers designed to make the transition into Canadian life easier.

SENIOR SPECIFIC SERVICES:

Integration Services for senior newcomers include specialized programs to facilitate adjustment to life in Canada and to encourage independence through social activities, interest groups and learning opportunities.
